Silicon Valley is one the key international regions for EIT Climate-KIC and multiple opportunities for highly impactful programmes focusing on tackling systemic climate challenges have already been identified through discussions with local partners and stakeholders. To develop these opportunities further and ensure effective delivery, there is a need for a consultant to develop EIT Climate-KIC's operational structures and programmes, with strong expertise in the following areas:  • Innovation ecosystems in Silicon Valley and relationship building • Coordination of European-Silicon Valley cooperation projects • Establishing organisational structures and legal entities  The consultant will lead the development of EIT Climate-KIC's operational structures in Silicon Valley, developing landscape maps and relationship building activities with key innovation agencies and overseeing projects with a focus on building European-Californian partnerships on climate innovation.
