

PDF TUTORIAL: How to indicate partner interest in collaborating on the European Green Deal Calls

EIT Climate-KIC is using our online collaboration and visualisation platform, Exaptive, to capture and visualise interest from across our Partnership community in collaborating on European Green Deal Call proposals. The intention of this mapping is to promote transparency and to facilitate and encourage self-matchmaking across the community on these opportunities.

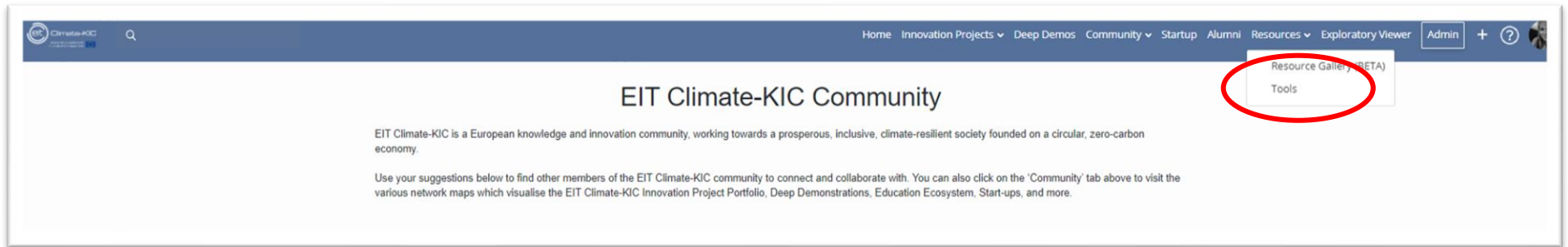
If your organisation is interested in collaborating with other organisations in the EIT Climate-KIC community on any of the European Green Deal Calls, please follow the below process to share this interest with EIT Climate-KIC and the rest of the community in Exaptive.

Step one: Log into the EIT Climate-KIC 'Cognitive City' in Exaptive platform, by following this link:

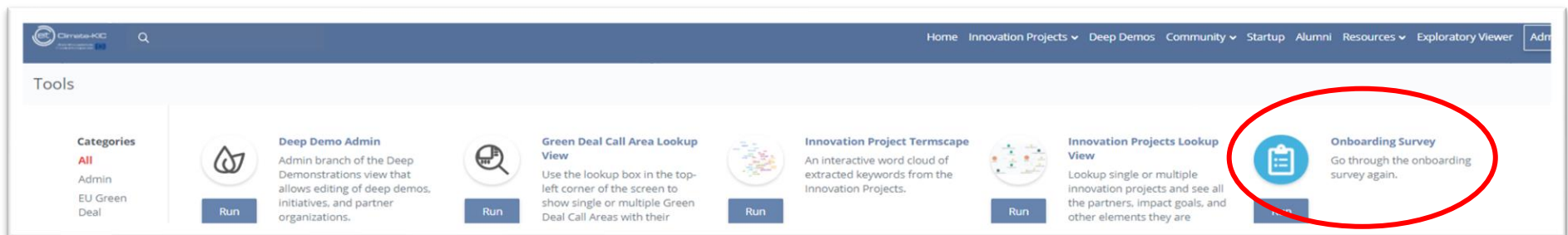

- If you are a new user to the platform, you will be automatically directed to the 'onboarding survey', which captures relevant information about you as a user, including which partner organisation you work for and which of the European Green Deal Call Areas and Topics your organisation is interested in.
- If you are an existing Exaptive user, you will land on the homepage when you log back in. You will need to go through the onboarding survey again in order to add the information about which partner organisation you work for and European Green Deal Call Areas and Topics your organisation is interested in. Note that all of the information you have previously added to your profile will still be there unless you explicitly choose to remove it.

To launch the onboarding survey, click on the **'Tools'** tab which can be found in the Resources drop down at the top right of the page:




Select the **'Onboarding Survey'** Tool:







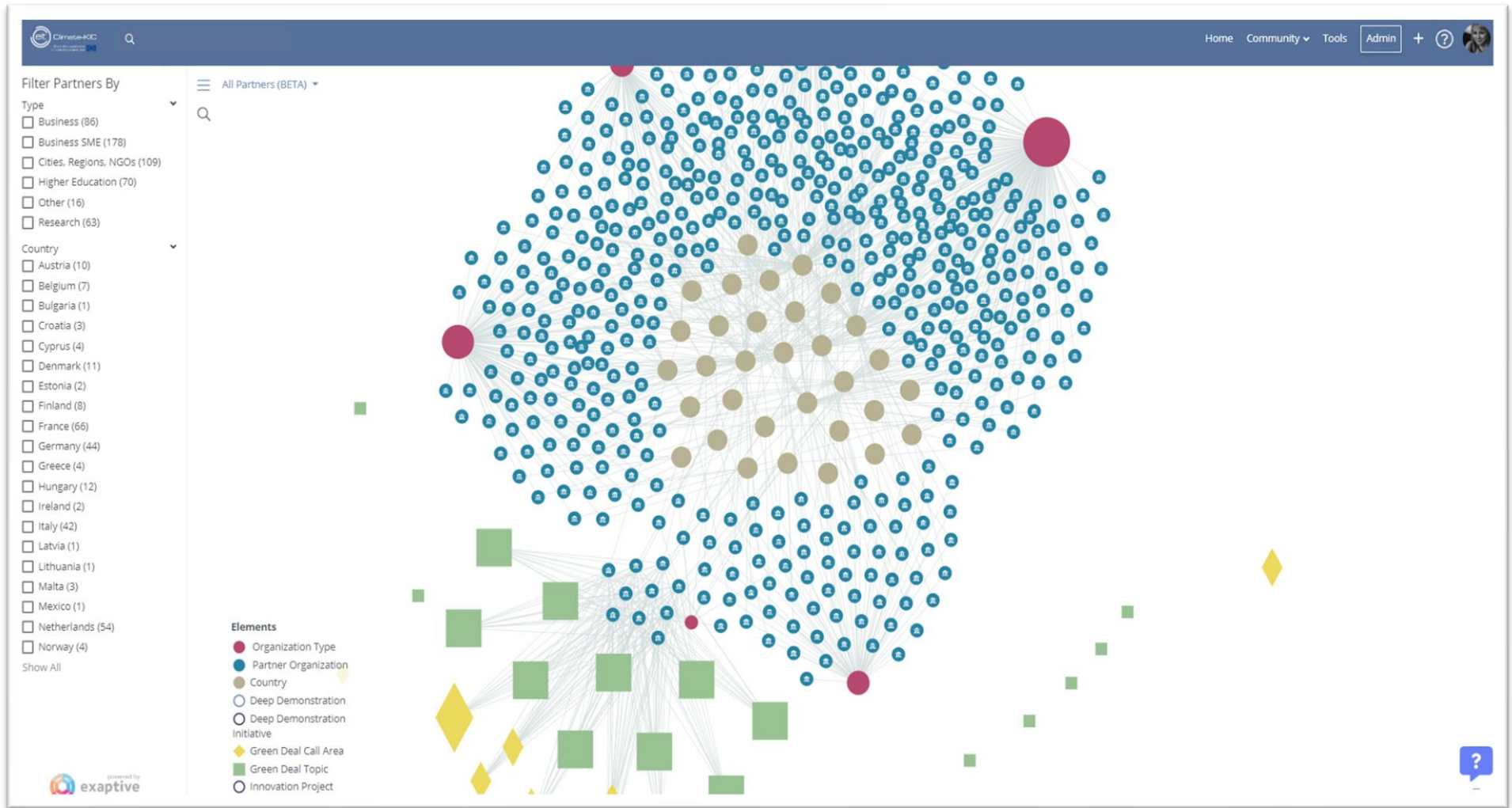



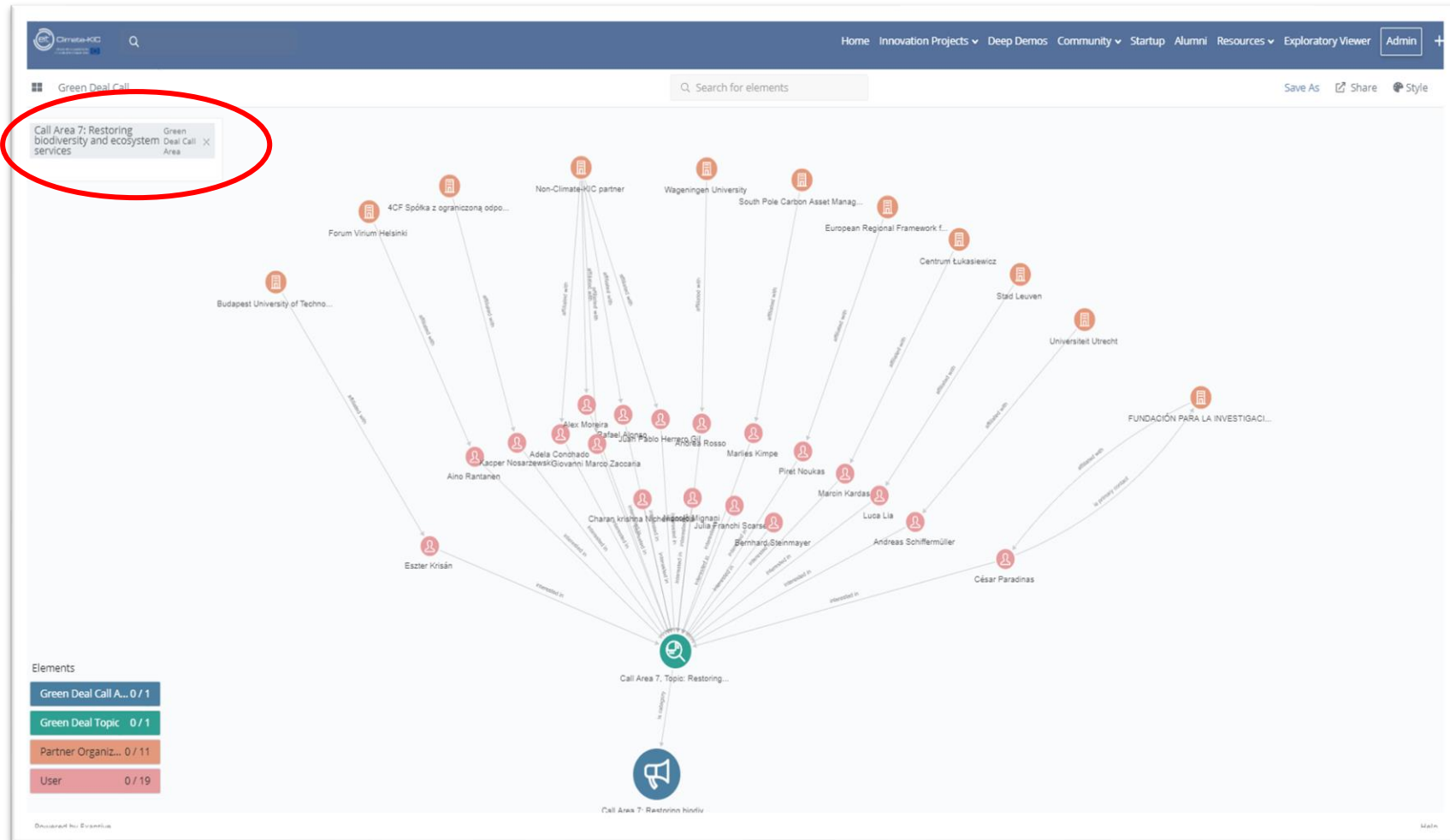
Exploring European Green Deal interest in the 'Exploratory Viewer'

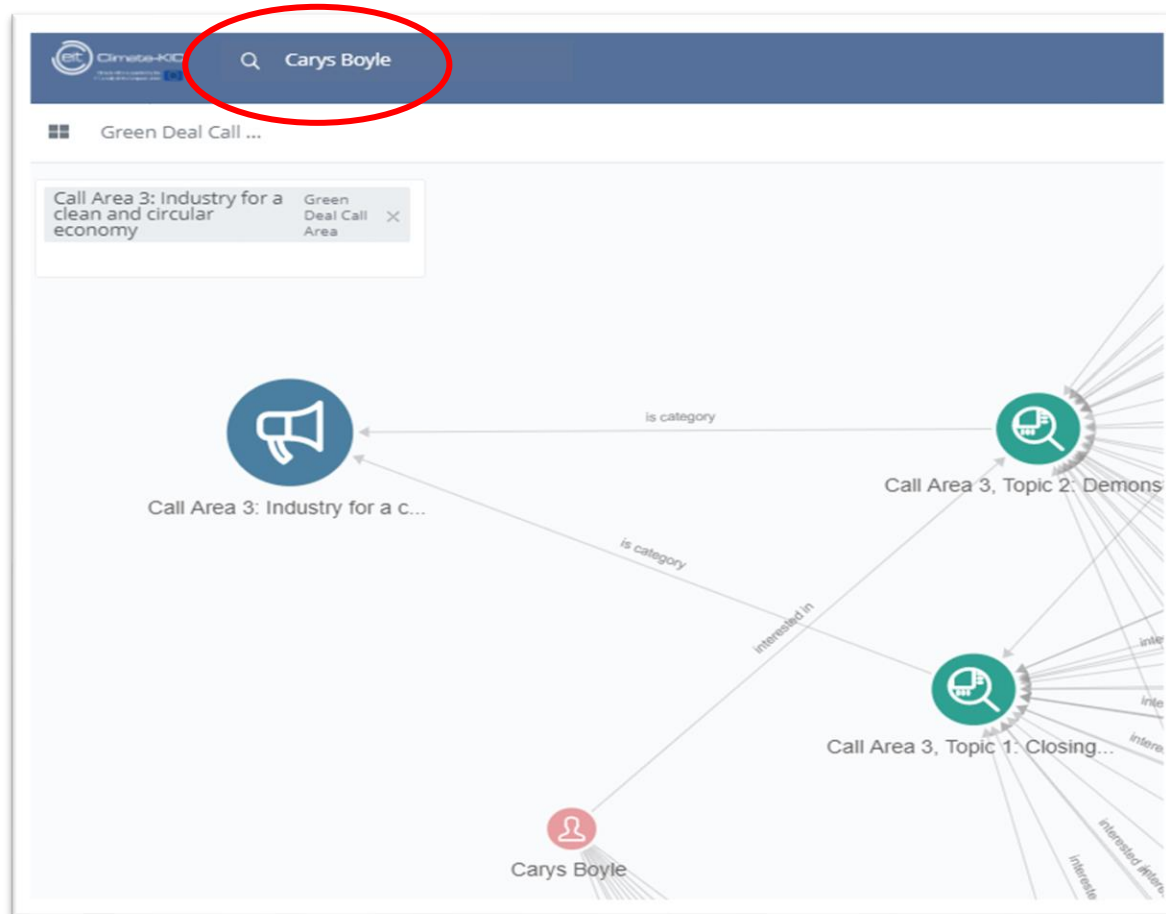


The view maps which users have expressed interest in which Call Areas/Topics, which Partner Organisation they represent, and what their level of interest is (i.e. 'leading' or 'participating' in a bid). To see the level of interest, users can click on the connection line between the User and the applicable Call Area Topic and the level will show in the information panel to the right:




Connecting to Potential Collaborators in Exaptive

Users can contact potential collaborators directly in the Exaptive platform, simply by searching for them in the universal search bar at the very top left of the screen:



This will direct to the profile of the user you are interested in. You can choose to 'connect' with them, or to see a comparison view of your common interests and complimentary differences.
