



What is carbon farming?

- **MAINTAIN**: To avoid future emissions by maintaining existing carbon stocks.
- **REDUCE**: To reduce emissions that cannot be avoided.
- **REMOVE:** To create new, long-term carbon stores.








5 key takeaways
